# Introduction

---

The Remember Me module allows your customers to choose to be remembered between visits to your store. When they login to their account, they have the option of allowing your store to remember who they are, even if they close their browser or shut down their computer. Then, the next time they visit your store using the same computer, they will be logged into their account automatically.

# Installation

---

## Installing the Module

1. Unzip the module's ZIP file to your hard drive
2. Log into your Miva admin utility
3. Expand the navigation tree next to Global Settings
4. Click the link "[Add]" next to the "Modules" link
5. Click the "Upload File" graphic
6. Click the "Browse" button
7. Browse to the location where you stored the files from extracted from the ZIP file
8. Select NBREMEM5.mvc
9. Click the "Upload" button
10. When the module has been uploaded, the small "Upload File" window will disappear, leaving you with the main Miva admin screen visible
11. Click the "Add" button on the main Miva admin screen

## Associating the Module with a Store

1. Inside of the Miva admin utility, click the link "System Extension Settings" under your store
2. In the assigned module list, you should see an entry for "NetBlazon's Remember Me"
3. Check the checkbox next to this module and click the Update button

# Module Settings

---

## Initial Settings

1. Click the “Remember Me” tab across the top of the “System Extension Settings” screen
2. When prompted, enter your license key and then click the Update button. The screen will refresh and show the module’s admin screen.
3. In the first textbox, enter the number of days before a cookie should expire. When a cookie expires, the customer will no longer be automatically logged in, until they again choose the “remember me” option.
4. The second line is an option to display the Remember Me checkbox on the store’s login screens. If you uncheck this, customers will no longer be able to choose this option, but customers who have already chosen to be remembered will still be automatically logged in.
5. The third line is an option to display the Remember Me checkbox on the store’s account add and edit screens. If you uncheck this, customers will no longer be able to choose this option, but customers who have already chosen to be remembered will still be automatically logged in.
6. Enter the text you wish to appear next to the checkbox on the login screen in the final textbox.
7. Click the Update button to save your changes.

# Checking the Component

---

**When you installed the module,  
it should have created a Remember Me component.  
To check, do the following:**

1. Click the “Pages” link on the left side of the Miva admin utility
2. Click the “Items” tab on the right side
3. Search for an item with the code “nb\_rememberme”

## **If for some reason this item is not found**

1. Click the “Add Item” button
2. Enter “nb\_rememberme” in the box labelled “Code”
3. Enter “NBREMEM” in the box labelled “Module” (or use the lookup utility to find the Remember Me module)
4. Click the “Add” button
5. Click the “Pages” tab at the top of the “Edit Item” page
6. Select all of the pages in your store by checking the boxes under the “Assigned” column.
7. Click the “Update” button
8. If there is a “Next” button at the bottom of the screen, click it and repeat the process of assigning the item to all of the store pages.

## **If you are using Miva 5.5**

1. Click the “Edit” Button
2. Click the “Pages” tab at the top of the screen
3. Make sure the item is assigned to all store pages. (When you add new pages, you need to make sure that this item is assigned. If not, those new pages will not log the customer back in if it’s the first page a customer visits in a new shopping session.)

## **If you are using Miva 5.0, you have to assign the item to each page individually**

1. On the left side of the Miva admin utility, click “Pages”
2. Click the “Edit” button next to the first page in the store
3. Click the “Items” tab at the top of the next page
4. Search for “nb\_rememberme”
5. Check the box under the “Assigned” column and then click the “Update” button at the bottom of the page
6. Repeat for every other page in the store.

# Adding Template Code

---

As a rule,

**our modules do not add their template code to your store automatically**

We have found that this causes unexpected problems with customized templates. As such, you will need to add some template code to your store so that the product and category titles from the module are used by the site. The examples below explain where to add the code based on the “Default MMUI Framework” templates. If you have customized templates or are using another framework, your existing code may be a bit different.

## HeadTag Insert

To find this, click the name of your store on the left side of the Miva admin utility. Then on the right side, click “HEAD Tag Content/CSS” (Miva Merchant 5.5) or “HEAD Tag Content” (Miva Merchant 5.0). Enter the following code anywhere in this box (putting at the top or bottom is usually the easiest route!):

```
<mvt:item name="nb_rememberme" param="LOAD" />
```

## Login Screens

The login screens in your Miva Merchant store are controlled by the LOGN and ORDL pages. The LOGN page is reached when the customer clicks the “Account” link, and the ORDL page is reached when the customer clicks the “Checkout” link. Both of these pages can have the Remember Me checkbox added to them. To do so, click Pages on the left side of the Miva admin utility, then on the right side, find LOGN and click its “Edit” button. Scroll down until you see the code for the radio buttons; it looks like:

```
<input type="radio" name="Action" value="LOGN" checked> Password: <input type="password" size="30" name="Customer_Password"><br> <input type="radio" name="Action" value="EMPW"> Please Email Me My Password
```

Just under that, add a new line and enter the following code:

```
<br /><mvt:item name="nb_rememberme" param="LOGN" />
```

Click the “Update” button when you are done. Repeat this process for the ORDL page.

# Adding Template Code continued

---

## Account Screens

The account screens in your Miva Merchant store are controlled by the ACAD and ACED pages. The ACAD page is reached when a customer chooses to create a new account, and the ACED page is reached when a customer chooses to edit an existing account. Both of these pages can have the Remember Me checkbox added to them. To do so, click Pages on the left side of the Miva admin utility, then on the right side, find ACAD and click its "Edit" button.

Scroll down until you see the code for the customer information; it looks like:

```
<mvt:item name="customer" />
```

Just under that, add a new line and enter the following code:

```
<br> <mvt:item name="nb_rememberme" param="CUST" />
```
