Introduction

The Page Title Manager PRO module allows you to specify titles to be placed on individual product and category pages within Miva Merchant. It also has a default page title for products and categories whose titles have not been individually set.

Installation

Installing the Module

1. Unzip the module's ZIP file to your hard drive
2. Log into your Miva admin utility
3. Expand the navigation tree next to Global Settings
4. Click the link "[Add]" next to the "Modules" link
5. Click the "Upload File" graphic
6. Click the "Browse" button
7. Browse to the location where you stored the files from extracted from the ZIP file
8. Select NBTITLESPRO5..mvc
9. Click the "Upload" button
10. When the module has been uploaded, the small "Upload File" window will disappear, leaving you with the main Miva admin screen visible
11. Click the "Add" button on the main Miva admin screen

Associating the Module with a Store

1. Inside of the Miva admin utility, click the link "Utilities" link under your store
2. In the assigned module list, you should see an entry for "NetBlazon's Page Title Manager PRO"
3. Check the checkbox next to this module and click the Update button

Module Settings

Initial Settings

1. Click the “Page Title Manager PRO” tab across the top of the “Utilities” screen
2. When prompted, enter your license key and then click the Update button. The screen will refresh and show the module’s admin screen.
3. If desired, change the default category and product page titles. These titles will be used for all categories and products whose individual titles have not been set within the module. You can use tokens as defined at the bottom of the screen.
4. Click the Update button to save your changes.

To override the default category title for a particular category

1. On the left side of the Miva admin, click Categories
2. Find the category whose title you wish to set, then click the “Edit” button
3. On the next screen, click the “Page Title Manager PRO” tab at the top
4. Enter your desired text in the box, and then click the “Update” button

To override the default product title for a particular product

1. On the left side of the Miva admin, click Products
2. Find the product whose title you wish to set, then click the “Edit” button
3. On the next screen, click the “Page Title Manager PRO” tab at the top
4. Enter your desired text in the box, and then click the “Update” button

Checking the Component

When you installed the module, it should have created a component named “nb_titles”.

To check, do the following...

1. Click the “Pages” link on the left side of the Miva admin utility
2. Click the “Items” tab on the right side
3. Search for an item with the code “nb_titles”

If for some reason this item is not found

1. Click the “Add Item” button
2. Enter “nb_titles” in the box labelled “Code”
3. Enter “NBTITLESPRO” in the box labelled “Module” (or use the lookup utility to find the Page Title Manager PRO module)
4. Click the “Add” button
5. Click the “Pages” tab at the top of the “Edit Item” page
6. Select the CTGY and PROD pages by checking the boxes under the “Assigned” column.
7. Click the “Update” button

If you are using Miva 5.5:

1. Click the “Edit” Button
2. Click the “Pages” tab at the top of the screen
3. Make sure the item is assigned to the CTGY and PROD pages.

If you are using Miva 5.0, you have to assign the item to each page individually:

1. On the left side of the Miva admin utility, click “Pages”
2. Click the “Edit” button next to the CTGY page
3. Click the “Items” tab at the top of the next page
4. Search for “nb_titles”
5. Check the box under the “Assigned” column and then click the “Update” button at the bottom of the page
6. Repeat for the PROD page

Adding Template Code

As a rule,

our modules do not add their template code to your store automatically

We have found that this causes unexpected problems with customized templates. As such, you will need to add some template code to your store so that the product and category titles from the module are used by the site. The examples below explain where to add the code based on the “Default MMUI Framework” templates. If you have customized templates or are using another framework, your existing code may be a bit different.

CTGY Page

To find this, click the “Pages” link on the left side of the Miva admin utility. Then on the right side, click the edit button for the “Category Display” (CTGY) screen. Remove the content between the <title> and </title> tags and replace it with this

```
<mvt:item name="nb_titles" param="title" />
```

So the first few lines will look like this:

```
<mvt:item name="html_profile" />
<head>
<title><mvt:item name="nb_titles" param="title" /></title>
<base href="&mvt:global:basehref;">
<mvt:item name="prodctgy_meta" param="ctgy" />
<mvt:item name="head" param="head_tag" />
</head>
```

Click the “Update” button after making the edit.

PROD Page

Repeat this process for the “Product Display” page (PROD).
